Occupation	Description
Academic staff of the university	Teaches at the university, lectures to students, conducts exercises and seminars, tests students' knowledge at exams, leads and consults the elaboration of diploma, bachelors and other theses. Participates in the creation of teaching texts and other teaching aids, in conducting research and other creative activities. Participates in professional workshops and conferences.
Accountant	Issues accounting documents, keeps accounting journals and accounting books and other records (paid wages, issued vouchers, receipts, etc.), performs inventories, checks factual and formal requirements of accounting documents. Enters data into the accounting system and processes them into various reports. Communicates with relevant authorities.
Accounting auditor	Performs independent verification of the company's financial situation by checking its accounting records. Verifies the accuracy of annual reports and financial statements. Controls significant accounting operations. Checks compliance with binding standards and legislation. Processes audit reports and discusses them with the client.
Actor	Portrays characters in theatre, television, radio or film works, commercials or entertainment programs. Studies the script, consults the role with the director, participates in rehearsals. Plays part in playing theatrical performances and making movies. Dubs foreign films or leads puppets and speaks for them.
Actuary	Performs actuarial calculations, mathematical modelling and calculations of insurance products. Evaluates statistical data (mortality, accidents, diseases, disabilities, fires, floods, etc.) and the probability that they will occur in clients. Suggests how high the clients of different categories should pay for different types of insurance contracts.
Acupuncturist	Performs treatment by stabbing needles into so-called acupuncture points in the patient's body. With the help of needles and small electric currents, helps to eliminate functional disorders of the organism, for example, to block pain at the level of the central nervous system, to regulate disturbed regulations of internal organs and to improve impaired motor functions.
Adjuster of production machines	Adjusts and maintains production machines. Checks workpieces and the quality of their machining.
Advertising and promotion specialist	Plans and manages the company's advertising strategy and tactics. It uses advertising on the Internet, advertising agencies, promotional materials, posters, flyers, brochures, competitions, discounts, etc.
Advertising copywriter	Creates original advertising texts and slogans that are intended to support the sale of products and services to be published in radio, television, corporate websites, social media, press releases, catalogues, etc. In many languages is called "copywriter".

Occupation	Description
Agricultural advisor	Provides advice to clients who are engaged in agriculture. Analyses the current state of agricultural production and proposes optimal solutions in the selection of production directions, in the search for subsidy programs, in the application of effective procedures for the treatment of livestock and crop production, for pest control, etc.
Agricultural machinery mechanic	Diagnoses, repairs, adjusts or maintains agricultural machinery and vehicles such as tractors, harvesters, dairy equipment and irrigation systems.
Agricultural manager	Plans and manages the administration and operation of livestock and / or crop production holdings. For crop production, oversees soil preparation before and after harvest, planting, cultivation, harvesting and sales. In animal production, oversees the proper care of livestock / poultry / bees. Provides agricultural machinery and its restoration. Is responsible for financial and marketing activities.
Agricultural production technician	Sets out technological procedures in animal husbandry and crop production in seed, vegetable and fruit growing and identifies suitable areas for animal husbandry and crop production. Evaluates the composition of the soil, the amount of precipitation, groundwater, the occurrence of pests and the resulting benefits and risks for breeding and cultivation.
Agronomist	Sets out procedures for growing agricultural crops in seed production, vegetable growing, fruit growing, plans and manages their sowing, fertilization and harvest. Selects seeds, fertilizers and other necessary raw materials and organizes their purchase and storage. Performs analyses and laboratory tests of soil and determines its so-called creditworthiness (a mark of its quality).
Air defence soldier	Performs professional activities related to the operation of equipment using radio or sound wave technology to identify, monitor and analyse objects or natural phenomena of military interest, and implements measures designed to prevent or reduce the effectiveness of enemy air attack.
Air force soldier	Performs professional activities related to the maintenance of military aircraft and airport equipment, operates air communications and detection equipment. Performs on-board equipment inspection before, during and after the flight. Provides operation and maintenance of aircraft weapons and security systems, refuelling, assists in loading and unloading aircraft.
Air traffic control specialist	Ensures safe takeoff and landing of commercial and military aircrafts. Is responsible for the coordination of air traffic control and maintenance staff, dispatching, the use of landing and navigation aids at the airport, the implementation of security procedures at the airport, the monitoring and maintenance of flight records and the use of knowledge of weather information.

Occupation	Description
Air traffic controller	Controls air traffic in the air and around the airport area, ensures safe take-off, landing and movement of aircraft inside the airport area. Communicates with aircraft crews, monitors the weather, solves non-standard and crisis situations. Keeps flight records.
Aircraft designer	Designs and develops design solutions for various types of aircrafts (transport, cargo, ultralight aircraft, helicopters, etc.) and their parts, selects suitable materials, tools and other equipment, performs the necessary calculations, determines the conditions of their operation, cooperates in their tests, prepares technical drawings and documentation.
Aircraft engine mechanic	Diagnoses, adjusts, repairs and maintains aircraft engines and their components, such as hydraulic and pneumatic systems. According to the operating regulations, performs their functional tests, maintains the relevant technical and operational documentation.
Aircraft systems technician	Provides maintenance and repair of on-board systems and control equipment in the aircraft. Installs, sets up and operates integrated computer / communication systems for aircraft and helicopters (or their simulators) for the collection and evaluation of data used in engine starting, take-off and positioning.
Ambulance driver	Drives the ambulance for the transport of the sick, injured or convalescents. Under professional supervision, participates in pre-hospital emergency care, assists in placing patients in ambulances. Performs routine ambulance maintenance.
An airborne soldier	Is member of a military unit equipped and trained to land from the air (parachute) from an airplane or helicopter to a destination. Undergoes rigorous training, must be physically fit, mentally resilient and immediately after the jump must be able to perform combat missions. During combat operations, is deployed to enemy territory, where performs various combat operations.
Anthropologist	Examines, evaluates and describes the physical, health, linguistic, cultural, social, political, economic and organizational development of mankind in various civilizations in human history, in order to understand and clarify the past of mankind and use findings to solve current social problems.
Archaeologist	Examines the past of mankind on the basis of material remains (buildings, objects, human remains, etc.), which searches for at archaeological sites, performs their purification, identification, conservation, cataloguing and storage. Processes maps of old settlements, describes the way of life of the people of that time.
Archivist	Performs archiving of professional, historical and other documents, library collections and collections. Processes the catalogue of archived materials, performs revisions and checks their condition. Supervises compliance with document archiving regulations. Performs archival lending service.

Occupation	Description
Art curator	Administers collections of artwork (paintings, sculptures, and other art objects), provides consultations and interpretations. In cooperation with other experts, professional institutions and state administration organizes their exhibitions in galleries, their transport and handling.
Art producer	Plans and organizes the preparation, course and completion of the creation, production and implementation of television, radio or film works, exhibitions, concerts and other cultural and public events, addresses their economy, sources of funding and compliance with laws and local regulations. Assembles and manages the production team, plans and manages the promotion of these works and events.
Artistic and sports agent	Represents artists and athletes (clients) in contact with current or potential employers. Looks for job opportunities for clients, negotiates the content of work, the amount of remuneration for work, employment contracts, benefits and other contract conditions.
Artistic blacksmith and locksmith	Designs, manufactures and repairs decorative and utility metal objects such as shields, coats of arms, decorative railings, handles, gates, metal sculptures, decorative objects for film or theatre. Restores historic metal objects.
Artistic pottery	Processes artistic designs and according to them produces ceramics and porcelain. Makes copies of works of art or historical value according to historical design.
Assembly worker for electronic devices	Assembles, adjusts and puts into operation low-current electronic devices such as digital clocks, illuminated advertisements, dishwashers, washing machines, televisions, videos, telephone lines, etc.
Assembly worker of electrical and energy equipment	Assembles components of electrical and energy equipment, adjusts and fixes them. Inspects finished components, equipment, wiring and circuits. Discards and replaces defective parts.
Assistant anaesthesiology	Helps anaesthesiologists to administer anaesthesia (the patient's artificial sleep or numbness of a certain part of their body during operations or other procedures). Cooperates in the preparation of patients for surgery, during the operation provides care, monitors condition and vital functions of patients, and helps to solve possible complications.
Assistant cook	Helps chefs with food preparation, ensures the preliminary preparation of ingredients and performs less demanding work procedures. Cooperates in ordering, accepting and storing food ingredients, treats kitchen utensils and equipment, and participates in cleaning the kitchen.
Astronomer	Observes, measures, studies and examines stars, planets and other cosmic bodies and objects, their systems, cosmic matter and energy, happening in space, its overall development. Applies and develops physical and other theories and methods dealing with the universe. Can also organize professional lectures and seminars for the public.

Occupation	Description
Attendant	Takes personal belongings (coats, bags, etc.) from participants of the event, stores them in the locker room, and gives them a ticket / stamp indicating the place of storage as a confirmation of storage. Upon completion of the event and presentation of the ticket / stamp, issues the stored personal belongings.
Audio and video technician	Installs, maintains and repairs equipment for audio and video recording (microphones, speakers, screens, displays, projectors, mixing consoles etc.). Selects suitable audio and video equipment and operates it when recording concerts, sports events, presentations, press conferences, etc.
Audiologist	Examines patients' hearing problems and performs diagnostic tests to determine the extent of damage and the source of hearing loss. Selects, prescribes and modifies suitable hearing aids and cochlear implants (electronic devices that deliver audio signals to the brain).
Author of instructions, manuals, handbooks	Writes instructions, manuals and handbooks for the use of technical equipment, appliances, household appliances, computer applications, etc., including instructions for their maintenance and safety of their use. Automotive specialist	Develops new or proposes innovations to existing structures and components of vehicles, engines, transmissions or other automotive systems using computer-aided design technology. Tests newly designed structures and components.
Automotive technician	Participates in the design of changes to the production of individual car components and tests these components on test equipment for performance, durability or efficiency. Installs test equipment, tests cars during test drives, records data for the needs of the development centre.
Auxiliary worker in agriculture	Plants, grows and collects vegetables, fruits, nuts, garden specialties and field crops by hands. Prepares and treats the soil, applies fertilizers, sprays against pests, irrigates, transplants, removes weeds, sorts and prunes plants, cleans, sorts, packs and loads collected products. Maintains fencing and cleans outbuildings.
Babysitter, au pair	Takes care of children of various ages, provides them with suitable activities at home, in hotels, in public children's corners and other areas. According to the agreement with the clients, he prepares food for the child, takes care of their clothes and clothes, etc. Can take care of the child only a few hours a week or live with the family and take care of the child full time.

Bank clerk for loans	Examines history and current financial situation of natural or legal persons applying for a loan, evaluates the risks of loan repayment, consults on loan approval, determines the conditions for granting a loan, draws up a loan agreement and concludes it with the client.
Banking specialist for capital transactions	Monitors and evaluates the development of the securities market (stocks, bonds, bonds, etc.). for purchase of the respective securities at a time when their price is relatively low and vice versa, for sale when their price is relatively higher. Informs clients about the situation on the capital markets with possible recommendations for purchase or sale and sells these purchases and sales to the bank.
Banking specialist for foreign exchange transactions	Monitors and evaluates the development of the exchange rates of individual currencies (Euro, Swiss francs, US dollars, etc.) and makes their purchases and sales so that the bank and its customers make money from it.

Beautician	Professionally treats the skin of clients, cleanses the surface, performs peeling, depilation, application of cosmetics and professional day and evening make-up. Provides professional advice on skin care and makeup.
Bicycle repairman	Repairs, adjusts and maintains bicycles.
Billor, payee	Enters data on products and services to be sold into the accounting system, issues invoices, checks them and sends them to customers. Receives invoices from suppliers, checks them and enters them into the accounting system, gives instructions to pay them. Keeps records of issued and received invoices, checks incoming and outgoing payments and matches them with invoices.
Bioinformatics	Collects and evaluates molecular-biological data, designs and manages databases of this data and develops algorithms for their processing and analysis. Uses this data in research of various specializations (pharmacology, medical technology, biotechnology, genetics, etc.).
Biologist	Examines the life of plants and animals from single-celled organisms to large animals. Conducts biological research and experiments during which monitors biological and cellular activity, compares samples included in the experiment with a control group, collects data and prepares reports. The findings are applied in medicine, pharmacology, veterinary medicine, agriculture, etc.

Occupation	Description
Biomedical assistant	Assists physicians in diagnosing patients' diseases with instruments and devices that monitor the physical and chemical processes in the human body and display them so that physicians can make a diagnosis. Provides maintenance of used devices and equipment, keeps the necessary documentation.
Biomedical specialist	Works as a non-physician in healthcare. Uses electrical, cybernetic, physical, mathematical and biological knowledge and experience to solve practical health problems, e.g. in the use of various diagnostic devices, in the construction of these devices and gadgets replacing or supporting the functions of the limbs and internal organs.
Blacksmith	Makes various metal components by forging, i.e.. heats the metal material in the furnace until it softens and then shapes it with a hammer. Also makes and deploys horseshoes and treats the hooves of farm animals. Repairs agricultural machinery and the blade of agricultural tools.
Bodybuilder and tinsmith	Performs assembly, disassembly and repair of automotive and rail vehicle bodies (grinds, welds, solders, putties, etc.) and straightens vehicle frames. Installs seals and vehicle body accessories.
Bookbinder	Finishes printed products such as books, brochures, mounts, by hand or machine on binding, finishing machines and presses.
Botanist	Examines plants, their species and genera, common and specific features, the possibilities of their use in various fields (biology, pharmacology, agriculture, etc.). Plans and coordinates the care of plants, prepares documents for public administration related to nature protection.
Brewmaster and maltster	Processes barley (by soaking, germination, roasting, decimation, sorting) and by further modifications (cleaning, cooking, cooling, fermentation, filtration) produces beer drinks, which fills into bottles or barrels.
Bricklayer	Performs qualified masonry work on the construction of new and reconstruction of existing buildings. Builds walls, arches, chimneys, fireplaces and other structures of bricks, concrete blocks, stone, etc. Establishes buildings, performs wall modifications (plaster, stucco), concrete work, lays paving and tiles, etc. Prepares mortar and concrete.
Broadcast message editor	Decides which events, information and stories will be included in the broadcasting of news programs (television, radio), how long they will be, which of the reporters, technical staff and transmission technology will be involved in the production of the report.
Broadcast technician	Installs, maintains, and repairs equipment used to transmit and receive radio and television signals. Operates devices to adjust the volume and quality of audio and video during broadcasting, solves technical problems during broadcasting.

Occupation	Description
Building and construction inspector	Performs control and inspection buildings and construction sites, controls the implementation of the construction in terms of compliance with project documentation, construction and other regulations. Focuses on general control or on a specific area (fire safety, statics, waterproofing, noise, heat, health safety, etc.).
Bus driver	Drives a bus or minibus and transports passengers for short or long distances on a regular line or on a one-time order. On some routes, manages the cash register, sells and checks travel documents. On long-distance connections, helps passengers to store their luggage.
Business economist	Sets out the company's financial strategies, economic plans and financial budgets. Processes analyses of the state of financial resources and results of the company, forecasts and recommendations for decision-making by the company's management. Represents the company in negotiations with audit, tax and accounting authorities.
Business manager	Plans and manages the sale of products or services to customers in order to maximize profits, creates a business strategy, business plan, monitors their implementation. It compiles statistics, which it then communicates with the company's management. It manages all employees of the sales department and provides their education and motivation. Conducts business negotiations with key clients and partners.
Butcher	Cleans, cuts and processes meat, produces meat products and canned food, processes animal fats, packs, ships and sells meat and meat products.
Cameraman	Operates a camera, shoots films, reportages for TV, promotion, social media, cinemas, etc., participates in the creation of visual effects, selection and editing of the filmed environment, artistic and lighting concept of scenes, while cooperating with directors or other cameramen.
Captain of shipping	Commands the vessel (ships commercial, cargo, tanker, container, liner, excursion, recreational, fishing, sports, war, etc.) and bears full responsibility for its operation, technical condition, navigation, crew, cargo, passengers, etc. Governs by the shipping and maritime law of the states in whose port or territorial waters is ship located.
Car electronics mechanic	Performs diagnostics, maintenance, adjustment and repair of electrical and electronic systems and devices in motor vehicles. Install, diagnose and repair motor vehicle communication, audio, safety and navigation equipment.
Car mechanic	Diagnoses, disassembles, repairs and maintains engines, mechanical and similar equipment of cars and trucks, motorcycles and other motor vehicles.
Car service manager	Takes over vehicles from customers, decides on the procedure of service inspections, diagnostics, maintenance and repairs of cars based on customer requirements, relevant regulations and the technical condition of vehicles. Career counsellor	Guides and helps clients to make independent decisions about initial and further education, about choosing a profession, professional change and finding a job on the labour market. Carer for animals in the zoo	Prepares, dispenses and serves the animals food, water, or medicines and other veterinary prevention products. Cashier in the store	Operates cash register, marks purchases using a reading device, receives cash and non-cash payments, issues cash documents, and accounts for sales at the cash register. Handles returns or exchanges of goods.
CEO of a large company	Is responsible for the management, administration and action on behalf of the company, controls compliance with processes within the company, proposes short-term and long-term strategy, represents the company in important business negotiations and negotiations, communicates with members of senior management, prepares regular reports for the board.
City building authority clerk	Performs activities related to state supervision in matters of building regulations. Consults with investors on the possibilities and conditions of construction. Conducts construction proceedings. Accepts applications for building permits, checks their formal side and assesses the conformity of the technical design of the building with the building regulations. Performs inspections of the construction, issues measures and ensures the approval procedure of the finished construction.

Occupation	Description
Civil architect	Designs new buildings (family houses, office buildings, theatres, factories, etc.) and the reconstruction of existing buildings. Prepares project documentation for building permits and construction, cooperates with designers of individual trades (water distribution, sewerage, wiring, gas, internet, etc.).
Claims adjuster in the insurance company	Records the damage events of the insurance company's clients, analyses them, evaluates and determines the claim and the amount of insurance indemnity. Cooperates with medical staff, the police and other experts and witnesses of the insured event. Calculates the compensation to be paid to client by the insurance company.
Cleaning worker	Performs cleaning work (cleaning floors, washing carpets, windows, shop windows, taking out garbage, etc.), routine daily maintenance of cleanliness, reporting faults and the need for repairs (doors, locks, lighting, etc.).

Climatologist	Examines and evaluates meteorological processes and climate on Earth, relates them in connection with other processes and events (volcanic activity, earthquakes, impacts of space bodies, Earth rotation, continent movements, development of human civilization, etc.), and derives forecast of future climate development.
Clinical data manager	Designs and updates databases of statistical health information and clinical study results. With knowledge of health care, evaluates data in databases, creates reports and graphs from them, and reports the trends that follow from them. Collaborates with statistics and mathematics.
Clinical psychologist	Provides support and treatment to individuals with mental illness and disorders. Evaluates their condition through observations, interviews, psychological tests and other psycho-diagnostic methods, explains and discusses their condition with them, recommends treatment, including recommendations for appropriate psychotherapy.

Develops computer programs for storing, locating and retrieving specific documents, data and information.

Operates fermenters, ovens and other equipment, including their maintenance, decorates cakes and desserts, produces ice cream and fruit cups, creates its own designs of desserts, cakes.
Conservator and restorer of museum collections	Professionally treats, restores and installs objects of historical value in the museum's collections (excavations, fossils of animals and plants, skeletal parts, historical weapons, clothing, books, documents, etc.).
