

Try with pupils from the last years of elementary school as part of career guidance

How to do it and to preserve the anonymity of the players?

The game can be play individually or under supervision of pupils. For access to supervised mode with pupils codes write to freibergova@asociacevp.cz. Pupils can enter the game without inserting their e-mails, and you will have an overview of their progress through the game. In a fun way, you will support their interest in future career and the related choice of educational path.

Game progress

1. Select a building on the city map and built it.
2. Acquaintance with information about vacancies in the given building.
3. Fill in the vacancy by answering simple quiz questions and obtain certain amount of point.
4. Complete missions that help to develop the city and increase city population.
